Executive Summary

The Lakota Group, the Village’s consultants for Planning and Landscape Design Services, will be presenting initial design concepts for the Village Center.

Discussion

On March 1, 2018, the Village Board approved engaging the Lakota Group for planning and design services for streetscape improvements in the Village Center/Ontarioville Historic District and to further develop the design of the recently adopted Village Center Plan update. The first phase of the Project takes the schematic design concepts of the Village Center plan towards more detailed design and layouts and provides for implementation of public improvements along Ontarioville Road and Devon Avenue, up to and including the limits of Ontarioville Park.

This phase of the design includes improvements beginning at the intersection of Church Road and Ontarioville, and envisions the use of recently acquired properties, to enhance the pedestrian environment, create seating and gathering spaces and enable future downtown development.

These streetscape improvements are intended to ‘jump-start’ development interest and include sidewalk improvements, possible bump-outs at intersections, landscape areas, outdoor seating areas, special paving areas, pedestrian scale lighting, and other enhanced pedestrian facilities.

This is the first step towards designing the physical improvements in the Village Center. Area businesses and property owners, as well as Metra, will be invited to attend this Workshop and will be further engaged in the process over the summer. We are also coordinating with ComEd for overhead wires to be relocated or buried. The improvements will be phased, with an eye towards the long range development potential of the TOD area. Once the design

concepts are agreed upon, cost estimates will be developed, and detailed construction drawings and specifications will be done.

At this time, overall design concepts will be presented to illustrate the use of Village-owned property, improvements in the public right-of-way, and future potential development concepts. This will also assist in demonstrating the Village's overall vision to potential TOD developers.

Review and discuss the overall design and Streetscape Improvements as presented by the Lakota Group for the Village Center/Ontarioville Historic District and provide feedback.
